ELIGIBILITY

- The applicant must be a senior at a Mercer County high school.
- The applicant must be planning to major in Environmental Science/Studies, Agriculture, Biology, Engineering, Conservation, Natural Resource Management, or similar.

CRITERIA

- The applicant must have exceptional academic achievement.
- The applicant must have significant involvement in school and community activities.
- Involvement in local conservation activities is preferred.

PROCEDURE

- The applicant must submit their completed form and supplemental materials via email to jrichael@mcc.co.mercer.pa.us by **February 28, 2022**.
- All applications must be typed. Hand-written applications will not be accepted.
- All questions must be answered completely, and all attachments must be submitted with the application.
- Applications must include a signature from the student, a parent/guardian, and a guidance counselor.
- All applications will be reviewed and awarded by the Mercer County Conservation District.
- The winner will be announced in Spring 2022, and the award will be presented to the winner during their high school's award ceremony.
